



## COPPERFIELD'S BOOKS CONSIGNMENT POLICY

Copperfield's Books sells books on consignment from Sonoma and Napa county authors whose titles are otherwise unavailable through our standard distributors (including Ingram, Baker & Taylor, and Partners West).

Submissions are considered for consignment on a store-by-store basis; acceptance is solely at the discretion of each store's Consignment Buyer. The author receives 55% of the sales price; the bookstore receives 45%.

Books must be professionally bound, with the title and author's name on the spine, preferably with an ISBN and price preprinted on the book cover. Book prices are determined by the author but should not be higher than online prices from our competitors. Placement of the books in our stores is at the discretion of the store staff.

Books are typically taken under contract for an initial period of three months (90 days), after which the Consignment Buyer will evaluate sales and decide either to close the contract or to extend the contract period. A request for payment for books sold is generated by the Consignment Buyer at the end of the contract; please allow 4-6 weeks for our Accounting Offices to mail a check. **Copperfield's does not accept books on consignment between Thanksgiving and New Year's.**

*Please note:* At the end of the contract, the consignor or their agent must pick up unsold copies; Copperfield's does not mail consignment books back. Books left 60 days or more beyond the end of the contract become the property of the store.
